



**STATUTES TO THE
CONSTITUTION OF THE
VANDERBILT STUDENT
GOVERNMENT**

1. Cabinet Organization

1.1. Overall Composition

- 1.1.1. The Cabinet shall be composed of the officers listed in the VSG Constitution, including the Treasurer, Finance Committee, Attorney General, Constitution and Statutes Committee, the Director of Publicity, and the Director of Technology.
- 1.1.2. The Cabinet shall also include a Director of Special Events and a Director of First-Year Relations. These positions shall be appointed by the Student Body President and confirmed by the House and Senate.

1.2. Duties

- 1.2.1. The duties of the Treasurer, Finance Committee, Attorney General, Constitution and Statutes Committee, and Director of Publicity shall include those listed in the Constitution. The duties of the Finance Committee shall also include those in the Student Finance Section of the Statutes.
- 1.2.2. The duties of the Director of Special Events shall include planning and coordinating all VSG Programming events not handled by House members and assisting the Organizational Relations Committee in planning all its events, including logistics, room reservation, refreshments, and itinerary.
- 1.2.3. The duties of the Director of First-Year Relations will oversee the Freshmen Leaders Program within VSG and organize the program's structure. The Director shall also be responsible for appointing and supervising the two co-chairs of the program.

2. Senate Organization

2.1. Faculty Senate Representative

- 2.1.1. The Speaker of the Senate shall appoint a representative to the Faculty Senate.
- 2.1.2. The duties of the Faculty Senate Representative shall include attending all meetings of the Faculty Senate, serving on any Faculty Senate committees that the Faculty Senate allows, reporting back to the Senate on these matters as directed by the Speaker, and presenting the Faculty Senate with any VSG proposals as directed by the Speaker.

2.2. Academic Affairs Representative

- 2.2.1. The Presidents of the School Councils shall together form the Academic Affairs Committee within the VSG Senate.

2.2.2. The Speaker of the Senate shall appoint one of the Council Presidents to serve as the Academic Affairs Representative.

2.2.3. The duties of the Academic Affairs Representative shall include coordinating the actions of the Academic Affairs Committee, maintaining contact with the Provost and Academic administrators, and arranging meetings between the Provost and members of VSG.

3. House Organization

3.1. Area Coordinator Duties

3.1.1. The Area Coordinators, in addition to their constitutional duties, shall also be responsible for organizing the Dinner Discussions events under the direction of the Speaker of the House.

4. Committee Organization

4.1. Organizational Relations Committee

4.1.1. The members of the Organizational Relations Committee shall include those listed in the constitution.

4.1.2. The appointed Co-Chair of the Organizational Relations Committee shall serve as the Chair of the AcFee Student Finance Committee, as governed in the Student Finance Section of the Statutes.

4.2. Dining and Facilities Committee

4.2.1. The members of the Dining and Facilities Committee shall include those listed in the constitution.

4.2.2. The Dining and Facilities Co-Chairs shall appoint a member of the committee to serve as the Environmental Representative. This member shall be a current VSG House President.
