Presentation of Resolution 07-08-21 "AcFee Restructuring"

The resolution puts the Student Finance Committee into statute form and restructures the AcFee process. Senator Smith proposed an amendment to Section 1 Parts C,D,E to read "appointed as the SCF, and also serving the professional or graduate student on a sub-committee." Also, the addition of clause F " Of the professional graduate student, at large student, and faculty member, no two can serve on the same sub-committee."

The amendment was passed unanimously.

Senator Smith proposed an amendment to Section 1 Definition of Contingency funds, "amounting to no more than 1% of the contingency fund budget."
